### Consideration of the Ōpōtiki Harbour Development Project

- 1. The proposed Ōpōtiki Harbour Development project (the proposal) is an agenda item for discussion at the Regional Economic Development (RED) Ministers meeting on 2 May 2018.
- 2. We understand that the Independent Advisory Panel (IAP), is aiming to provide you with advice on whether the proposal should receive investment prior to the RED Ministers meeting. The IAP will not be in attendance at the RED Ministers meeting.
- 3. Officials attended both of the sessions where the IAP considered the proposal. We provide a summary of the key factors from IAP discussion impacting the Government's ability to support the proposal below.

#### **Key Factors for the Proposal**

- 4. The IAP deliberation covered a wide range of issues but ultimately centred on four critical areas of concern around the Detailed Business Case (DBC) that Opōtiki District Council provided in support of the proposed Provincial Growth Fund (PGF) investment.
- 5. Broadly, the Provincial Development Unit (PDU) and other Ministry of Business, Innovation and Employment (MBIE) officials agree with the factors the IAP identified. The four areas are:



- Accordingly, we anticipate that the IAP recommendation will be that the Opotiki Harbour Development proposal not receive PGF investment, but that the community be encouraged to consider creative alternative economic development proposals that might be considered for PGF support.
- 7. The IAP has considered that there could be an impact on the Agreement in Principle (AIP) the Crown reached with Whakatohea for a settlement package in 2017 but this did not appear to impact their view of the fundamental case for harbour investment.
