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Purpose

This briefing requests that you review the terms of the Provincial Growth Fund (PGF) decision for the Manfield National Driver Training Centre project.

On 5 November 2018, RED Ministers approved total funding of \$2,862,000, comprising \$^{commercial Information} loan for capital expenditure and \$^{commercial Information} loan for operating expenditure for the Manfield National Driver Training Centre project.

The Provincial Development Unit (PDU) requests the review of the terms attached to the proposed funding component of \$ for operating expenses, and that RED Ministers agree to fund the operating expenses as a grant rather than a loan.



Recommended action

The Ministry of Business, Innovation and Employment recommends that you:

- a **Note** the contents of the briefing to inform your decision making on the Manfield National Driver Training Centre proposal.
- b **Agree** to fund the operating expenditure component of \$^{Commercial Informat} as a grant rather than a loan.

Background

- 1. On 5 November, RED Ministers considered a request for \$2,862,000 of PGF funding for Manfield National Driver Training Centre.
- 2. Manfeild Trust's proposal is to extend the National Driver Training Centre's Class 1 drivers training program to incorporate Class 2 to 5 (the full range of driver training). The proposal is directly aimed at the region's logistics and road transport industries and is relevant for regional economic development more broadly.
- 3. Ministers were supportive of this project, which would make a strong contribution to human capital and skills in Manawatu-Whanganui. The Independent Advisory Panel (IAP) reported that they had recommended meeting the sought funding to score information for capital expenditure, but not the operating costs of score information.
- 4. Ministers agreed with the suggestion from officials and the IAP that the applicant should receive the full \$2.862 million, with the minutes noting that the full amount be provided through a loan. Given the skills development objective of the proposation an area of priority to the Government, Ministers were comfortable with the loan being provided on concessionary commercial terms.
- 5. The agreed action was for the PDU to work with the applicant to finalise the structure of PGF investment, comprising \$^{Commercial Information} loan for Capital Expenditure and \$^{Commercial Information} loan for Operating Expenses.

- 7. The project has significant community and industry support. The PDU believes that by providing the operational expenditure as a grant rather than a loan we are best positioning the applicant to be successful.

Next Steps

8. If you agree to the proposal to provide a grant rather than a loan for the Operating Expenses of \$^{Commercial Information}, the PDU will negotiate with the applicant to ensure appropriate controls are in place to manage the distribution of funds against KPI performance indicators.
