5.3 Te Ara Mahi (TAM)/He Poutama Rangatahi (HPR) updates

In June 2019, The Development Hub (TDH) received a PGF grant of \$780,434 to expand its Initiate programme. This is an evidence-based preemployment programme involving individual assessments, counselling, and interactive and multi-layered education interventions designed to change critical thinking.

Their most recent quarterly report covers the period up to Commercial Information and indicates that, of people being helped to date, have moved into either employment or further education, with of those having identified as having substance abuse issues.

PCFL Directors are meeting with the PDU on 3 February 2020. The PDU will soon send you and the Minister of Finance (as shareholders on PGFL) a briefing seeking approval to the subscription agreement for PGFL. Agreeing the Subscription Agreement is the first step to enable the Company to be capitalised via equity so that it can be funded to meet their obligations under investment agreements that will be transferred to them. Following the approval of the Subscription Agreement, the PGFL Board will be able to make their first call on capital to receive funding.
