Total available capacity is 7,854. Effective capacity allows for 24 hour room turn-around between guests to allow for health and cleaning requirements between arrivals and departures. These requirements are much more thorough than a standard hotel room clean, and include the use of PPE equipment, sanitising and deep cleaning.

#### INCIDENT REPORTS

This section reports on any incidents in the last 24 hours that present a potential or actual risk to public health

25 August 2020 – Around 11pm on 23 August a man entered the exterior area of the Sudima Rotorua Managed Isolation facility by allegedly pushing sections of fencing apart. The man walked around 35m to an exterior staff area, before exiting the facility. The exterior area entered was not accessible to returnees and the health risk has been assessed as low. The man was seen leaving the facility by a member of the public who called Police. The man was located by officers and warned. Fencing at the facility has been reinforced.
