Total available capacity is 7,930. Effective capacity allows for 24 hour room turn-around between guests to allow for health and cleaning requirements between arrivals and departures. These requirements are much more thorough than a standard hotel room clean, and include the use of PPE equipment, sanitising and deep cleaning.

INCIDENT REPORTS

This section reports on any incidents in the last 24 hours that present a potential or actual risk to public health

17 September 2020 – Yesterday at 11pm a returnee staying at the managed isolation facility at the Sudima Lake Rotorua was reported missing from their room. An immediate search began, and the person was located by NZDF staff near the facility around 11:30pm. Initial information is that the individual exited through a fenced area. Public Health advise the COVID-19 health risk has been assessed as low. The individual tested negative for their day three test and is symptom free. There is no information to suggest the individual came into contact with any other person while outside the facility. Police enquires are underway and the individual is receiving support and assessment in hospital.
