Total available capacity is 7,885. Effective capacity allows for 24 hour room turn-around between guests to allow for health and cleaning requirements between arrivals and departures. These requirements are much more thorough than a standard hotel room clean, and include the use of PPE equipment, sanitising and deep cleaning.
