Operational Capacity allows for 24 hour rooms turn-around between guests to allow for health, cleaning and maintenance requirements between arrivals and departures. The difference between Operational Capacity and Occupancy does not represent room availability as this is a daily snapshot. A true measure of occupancy is over 14 days, as occupancy listed today may actually be needed in the coming days for incoming flights.

Projected occupancy is based on current ticketing sales provided by airlines and the MIAS system. The use of the Managed Isolation Allocation System is now mandatory and will become the primary source of data from 17 November 2020. MIQ is working with airlines to ensure current ticketing sales do not exceed capacity and all returnees have an MIAS voucher.
