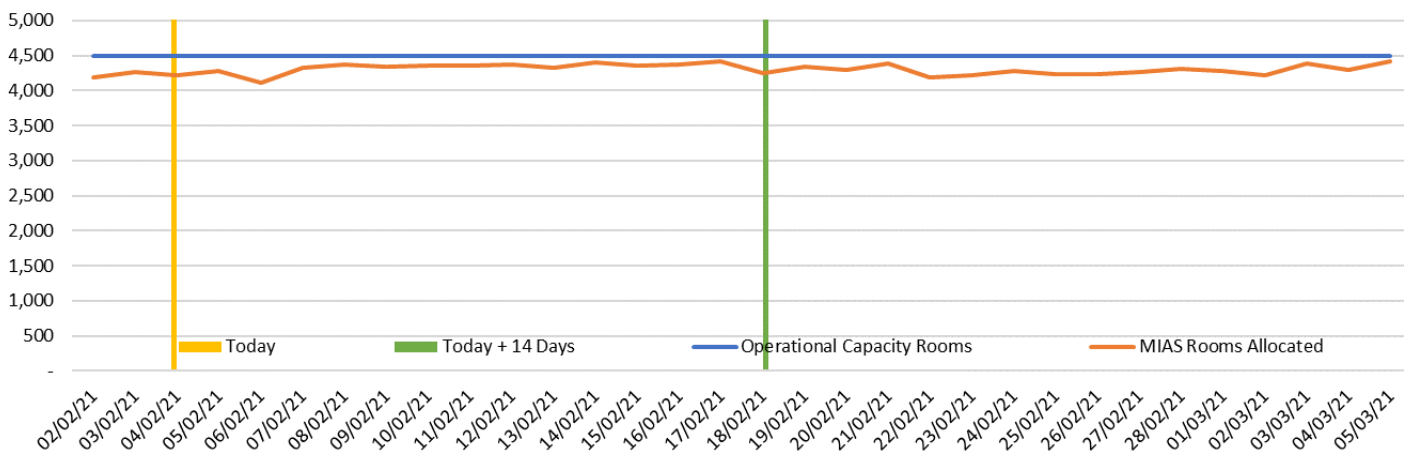

MANAGED ISOLATION ALLOCATION SYSTEM (MIAS) ROOMS ALLOCATED

Rooms in our managed isolation facilities are needed for 14 days. The below graph illustrates room allocation rates over the coming weeks. If the room allocation rate is projected to reach the operational capacity level in the next 14 days, no additional rooms can be allocated in the days leading up to this peak.
