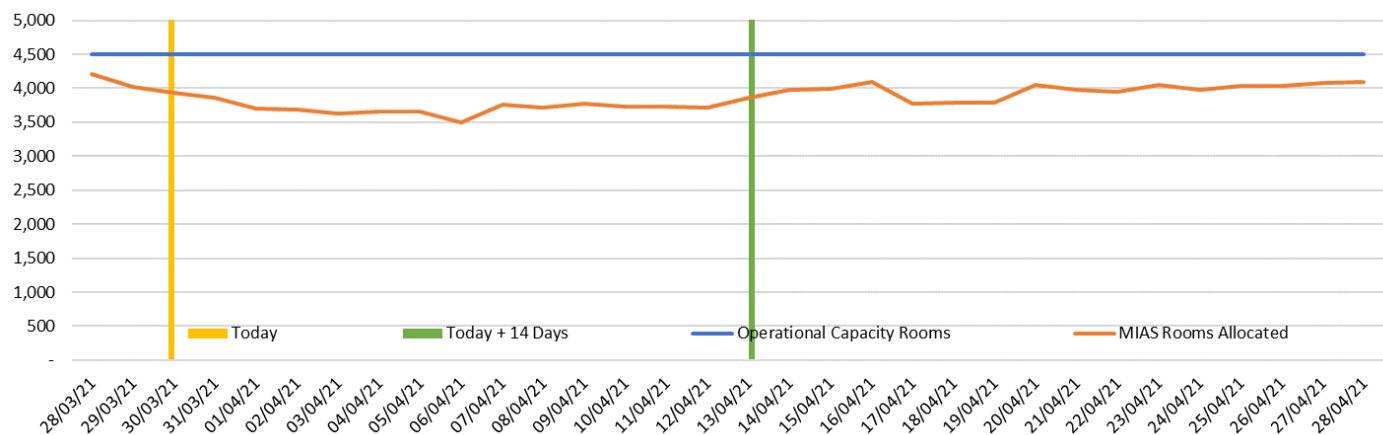

MANAGED ISOLATION ALLOCATION SYSTEM (MIAS) ROOMS ALLOCATED

Rooms in our managed isolation facilities are needed for 14 days. The below graph illustrates room allocation rates over the coming weeks.
