2. PROVINCIAL GROWTH FUND UPDATES

2.1 Provincial Growth Fund

Eliot Linforth-Hall Privacy of natural persons

As at 13 April 2018, 16 new queries, expressions of interest (EoIs) and applications have been processed from the PGF portal into the pipeline since last week. In total, there are 131 queries, EoIs and applications in the PGF pipeline.

The Provincial Development Unit (PDU) is also completing a series of new application documents and application assessment forms for \$0-\$1million, \$1-\$20million and over \$20million. Additionally, the PDU is on track to begin using its new pipeline tracking platform – Pipe Drive - on Monday 16 April. This will bring efficiencies to the processing, tracking and reporting functions of the Unit relating to EoIs and applications.

2.2 Wairoa

The Senior Regional Official (SRO) for Hawke's Bay, Carl Crafar, and the PDU's Regional Lead for Hawke's Bay met with the CEO of the Wairoa District Council (WDC) last week. The purpose of the meeting was to:

- 1. Ensure all PGF queries, EoIs and applications had been received;
- 2. Discuss capacity needed to convert queries and EOIs into PGF applications;
- 3. Identify next steps toward gaining approval and implementation of proposals.

The CEO confirmed that WDC had capability to complete EOIs/applications for the remaining four PGF referrals. However, it was noted that further resources may be required to develop business cases. Officials will meet again to determine the assistance required.

A PGF proposal for improving skills and employment opportunities for Wairoa youth from the WDC has now been signed-off by the Wairoa Partnership Group. Officials expect to receive the final proposal shortly.

2.3 Gisborne/Tairawhiti

The launch of the PGF in Gisborne on 23 February 2018 continues to generate a high level of interest and action amongst regional stakeholders.

The development of a centre of excellence for wood processing is a high priority for the Gisborne region. On Wednesday 4 April Officials from MBIE and MPI accompanied Under-Secretary Fletcher Tabuteau to Gisborne to meet with the Wood Processors' and Manufacturers' Association of New Zealand, and later with the Gisborne Tairawhiti Action Plan Steering Group.

2.5 Meeting with Minister Twyford re Northland

On 9 April, Officials from MBIE, MoT and MPI met with Minister Twyford to discuss transport, housing and regional economic development projects in Northland. The discussion focused on a programme of work leading to announcements by the Prime Minister in Northland on 1 June 2018. Ben Dalton, the SRO for Northland, has agreed to lead the work with input from agencies and to meet regularly with Ministers to update them on progress.

2.6 Pipeline project - Kaikoura and Hurunui visit by officials 4/5 April

Officials from MBIE and MPI with Independent Advisory Board Chair, Rodger Finlay visited Kaikōura and Hurunui Districts to meet with Mayors, CEs and relevant local stakeholders on 4/5 April.

This visit involved a series of meetings with stakeholders to understand the remaining land and building damage post-earthquake, and discuss potential tourism and economic development opportunities. Actions from the meetings include:

- 1. A further follow up visit from officials regarding the proposed cycle trail from Picton to Kaikōura. This will include officials from the New Zealand Cycle Trail Team, the New Zealand Transport Agency, and MBIE.
- 2. MBIE will work with Mayors and the Canterbury Mayoral Forum on a proposal for feasibility funding to explore options with the harbour, airport, heritage trail and a marine research centre.
- 3. MBIE and MPI will work further with Mayors around options of land remediation and potentially a tailored afforestation scheme that will address their specific needs for damaged land, plantation forestry, other tree planting options or retiring the land.

Officials will keep you updated on progress.

3. OTHER UPDATES

3.1 Draft Estimates of appropriation

MBIE Finance worked with the Treasury to finalise the Estimates documents (Supplementary for 2017/18 and Main for 2018/19), reflecting Cabinet decisions about the Regional Economic Development appropriations. Officials worked with the Minister's Office on content for the Overview section of the Main Estimates, which sets out the composition of the \$1 billion of funding for the Provincial Growth Fund in 2018/19.

The Minister has reviewed and approved the RED Estimates. The RED Estimates, along with all the other portfolios within Vote Business, Science and Innovation, will go to the Minister for Economic Development (as Vote Lead Minister) on Monday 16 April for sign off by the end of next week.
