Portfolio ACC

On 21 October 2021, the Cabinet Legislation Committee:

- 2 **approved** the government response, attached to this submission, to the five ACC-related petitions;
- 3 **noted** that the government response must be presented to the House of Representatives by 2 November 2021;
- 4 **invited** the Minister for ACC to present the government response to the House in accordance with Standing Order 380;
- 5 **invited** the Minister for ACC to write to the petitioners enclosing a copy of the government response to the petitions, after the response has been presented to the House.
