Major Events Management (Rugby World Cup 2021 (Playing in 2022)) Order 2022

Portfolio Economic and Regional Development

On 5 May 2022, the Cabinet Legislation Committee:

- 1 **noted** that the Minister for Economic and Regional Development recommends that the Governor General, by Order in Council, declare the Rugby World Cup 2021 (Playing in 2022) to be a 'major event' and certain associated emblems and words to be 'major event emblems and words' under the Major Events Management Act 2007;
- 2 **noted** that before recommending the making of an Order in Council, the Minister for Economic and Regional Development consulted with the Minister of Commerce and Consumer Affairs and the Minister for Sport and Recreation and other persons as required under sections 7 and 8 of the Major Events Management Act 2007;
- 3 **noted** that the Major Events Management (Rugby World Cup 2021 (Playing in 2022)) Order 2022 gives effect to the decision referred to in paragraph 1 above;
- 4 **authorised** submission to the Executive Council of the Major Events Management (Rugby World Cup 2021 (Playing in 2022)) Order 2022 [PCO 24394/6.0];
- 5 **noted** that the Major Events Management (Rugby World Cup 2021 (Playing in 2022)) Order 2022 comes into force on 9 June 2022.
