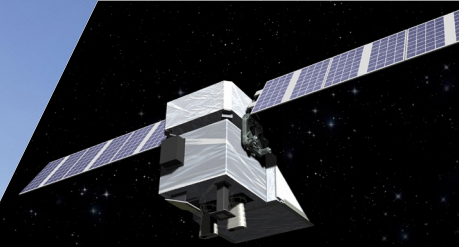


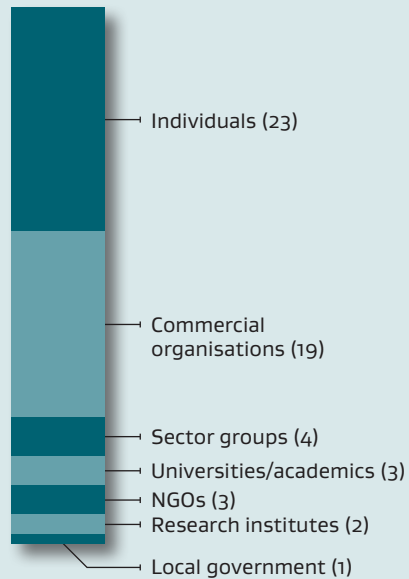

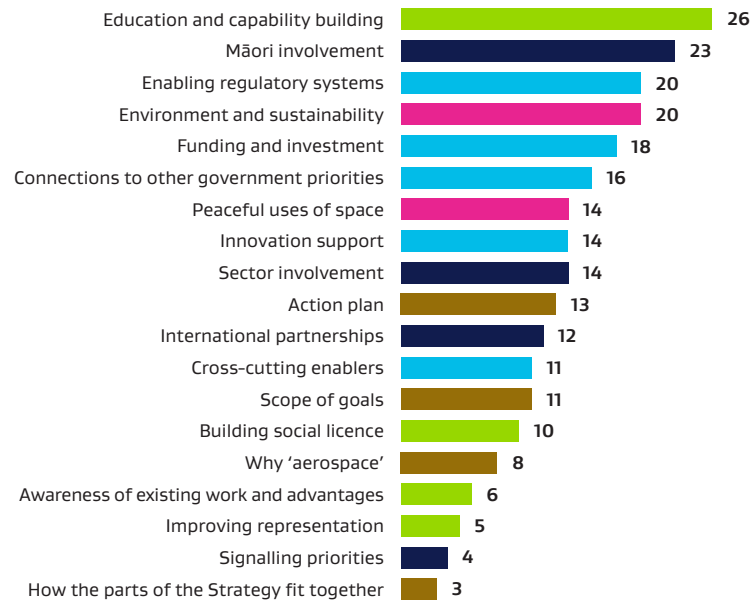

- 1 **Education and capability**
Include a workstream in the Action Plan on education and capability to support opportunities at all levels.
- 2 **Māori involvement**
Progress research on Māori participation in aerospace and establish processes for ongoing involvement in implementation.
- 3 **Enabling regulatory systems**
Progress enhancements to our regulatory systems to support innovation.
- 4 **Environment and sustainability**
Emphasise sustainability throughout the Strategy and broaden the scope of sustainability goals.
- 5 **Funding and investment**
Highlight existing investments and opportunities for funding under the Strategy.
- 6 **Connections to other government priorities**
Highlight work underway across government.
- 7 **Peaceful uses of space**
The Strategy will be consistent with the New Zealand Space Policy.
- 8 **Innovation support**
Note current support and explore further needs as part of Action Plan.
- 9 **Sector involvement**
Establish mechanism for sector involvement in implementation.
- 10 **Action plan**
Publish initial Action Plan with Strategy and update over time.
