



- Education and capability
  Include a workstream in the Action Plan on education and capability to support opportunities at all levels.
- Māori involvement
  Progress research on Māori participation in aerospace and establish processes for ongoing involvement in implementation.
- Bnabling regulatory systems
  Progress enhancements to our regulatory systems to support innovation.
- Environment and sustainability
  Emphasise sustainability throughout the Strategy and broaden the scope of sustainability goals.
- Funding and investment
  Highlight existing investments and opportunities for funding under the Strategy.
- **Connections to other government priorities** Highlight work underway across government.
- Peaceful uses of space
  The Strategy will be consistent with the New Zealand Space Policy.
