### Self-contained Motor Vehicles Legislation Bill: Approval to Release a Supplementary Order Paper

On 4 May 2023, the Cabinet Legislation Committee:

- 1        **noted** that in March 2023, Cabinet Economic Development Committee (DEV) agreed that the ability to extend the current two-year transition period in the Self-contained Motor Vehicles Legislation Bill (the Bill), by Order in Council, for a maximum of 24 months be progressed, via Supplementary Order Paper, through the Committee of the whole House stage [DEV-23-MIN-0037];
- 2        **agreed** to remove the provisions that presumes a defendant is a person who is in New Zealand on the basis of a visitor visa;
- 3        **noted** that Ministry of Business, Innovation and Employment's Departmental Report recommended a number of changes to the Bill that were not progressed at the time and are instead being progressed through this SOP;
- 4        **approved** the Supplementary Order Paper to the Self-contained Motor Vehicles Legislation Bill [PCO 23555-1/8.0], attached to the submission under LEG-23-SUB-0047, (subject to any minor editorial changes) for release;
- 5        **noted** that the Bill should be enacted in May 2023 in order for the Act to be in force and the Regulations that set the infringement fee and fine levels are in force prior to the FIFA Women's World cup in July 2023.
