We strongly advocate for greater investment in minor repairs - there is a great need for this in our rohe, particularly across Te Tai Tokerau. The Foundation is mindful that severe housing deprivation is highest among young Pacific peoples and young Māori, while overall, severe housing deprivation prevalence rates for Pacific peoples and Māori are close to four and six times the Pakeha rate. Foundation North has provided funding to enable a Northland housing repair initiative, sitting alongside Warmer Kiwi Homes, and are happy to share learnings from this.
