## Portfolio <br> ACC

On 23 May 2024, the Cabinet Legislation Committee:
1 noted that in March 2024, the Cabinet Social Outcomes Committee agreed to amend the Accident Compensation Act 2001 to explicitly allow ACC to charge debit interest when levy payers opt to pay by instalments [SOU-24-MIN-0101];

2 noted that the Accident Compensation (Interest on Instalment Plans) Bill holds a category 3 priority on the 2024 Legislation Programme (to be passed by the end of 2024);

3 noted that the Accident Compensation (Interest on Instalment Plans) Amendment Bill will amend the Accident Compensation Act 2001;

4 approved the Accident Compensation (Interest on Instalment Plans) Amendment Bill [PCO 25151/8.0] for introduction;
agreed that the Accident Compensation (Interest on Instalment Plans) Amendment Bill be introduced on 30 May 2024 as part of Budget night legislation;

6 agreed that the Government propose that the Accident Compensation (Interest on Instalment Plans) Amendment Bill be passed through all stages under urgency as part of Budget night 2024 legislation.
