# Recommended visa durations for certain offshore general visitor visa applicants

#### Context

The advice in this Visa Pak replaces the advice previously communicated to staff in Visa Pak 524.

Immigration Instructions  $\underline{V2.15}$  sets out the maximum durations that multiple entry visitor visas can be granted for. The following guidance has been updated to help ensure more efficient processing of applications by minimising risks and to provide a better, more consistent, service to our customers.

From Monday 17 June 2024, these visa conditions are considered to be the starting point \$ 6(c)

### Recommended visa durations - offshore applicants

Visa Waiver nationals	N/A	3 years	3 months	М

<sup>\*</sup>Philippines has a bilateral fee waiver with New Zealand but the duration of stay cannot be more than 59 days unless they have paid a fee, in which case their travel and stay expiry dates can be granted in line with other visa required nationals.

### **Additional considerations**

Immigration officers (IO) have discretion to vary these durations based on each applicant's individual circumstances.

IOs may consider a longer visitor visa duration, for example for applicants who are travelling to visit family and intend to stay in New Zealand for more than the recommended visa durations and the requested duration is permitted under the visitor visa instructions.

## **Applications in ADEPT**

If IOs process an offshore general visitor visa application in ADEPT and 6(c)

## Passport duration

Passport duration still needs to be considered as per Immigration instructions <u>E3.10</u>. For example, if the IO wants to grant a five-year multiple entry visa to a Chinese national as per the table above, but the passport is only valid for three years, they can only grant a visa to the date specified in the immigration instructions <u>E3.10</u>. They cannot grant a five-year multiple entry visa into a passport with only three years validity.
