Consumer Data Right: Release of Banking and Electricity Discussion Documents

Portfolios Energy / Commerce and Consumer Affairs

On 21 August 2024, the Cabinet Economic Policy Committee:

- **noted** that in May 2024, the Cabinet Legislation Committee:
 - 1.1 agreed that the electricity sector be assessed for designation under the criteria set out in the Customer and Product Data Bill (the Bill) alongside the assessment of the banking sector;
 - 1.2 invited the Minister of Commerce and Consumer Affairs to report to the Cabinet Economic Policy Committee by July 2024 regarding the potential designations being explored under the criteria set out in the Bill;

- 2 **noted** that the discussion documents attached to the paper under ECO-24-SUB-0171 propose consultation on potential designations of the banking and electricity sectors under the Bill, including the problem definitions, potential scope of the designations, and their costs and benefits:
- **authorised** the Minister of Commerce and Consumer Affairs to approve minor changes and edits to the discussion document on *Open Banking Regulations and Standards under the Customer and Product Data Bill* (Appendix 1 to the paper under ECO-24-SUB-0171) prior to its publication;
- **authorised** the Minister for Energy and the Minister of Commerce and Consumer Affairs to approve minor changes and edits to the discussion document on *Exploring a Consumer Data Right for the Electricity Sector* (Appendix 2 to the paper under ECO-24-SUB-0171) prior to its publication;
- **approved** the release of the two discussion documents referred to above for up to a six-week public consultation beginning in August 2024.
