This appropriation is limited to providing support for North Island weather events advisory groups and other related governance structures.

#### **Intention Statement**

This appropriation is intended to improve the safety of Auckland city centre by establishing three city centre Safety Hubs in Auckland to enable the Akarana Māori Warden group to have a more effective presence.

The appropriation was underspent after the Queen Street location was not deemed suitable due to issues with the maintenance of the fire exits.
