Report on Overseas Travel: Hon Shane Jones – October 2024

I recommend that Cabinet note this report on my travel to Singapore from Sunday 20 October to Friday 25 October to participate in Singapore International Energy Week (SIEW) and engage with Singapore for potential Foreign Direct Investment into New Zealand regional infrastructure projects.

Report

- 1 I participated in the Ministerial Dialogue panel session during the opening Summit of Singapore International Energy Week (SIEW) 2024. I painted a pragmatic picture of New Zealand's approach in balancing the challenges of energy security, sustainability, and affordability. I also noted New Zealand's geothermal resources and opportunity to expand these further through deeper geothermal wells, while also acknowledging the ongoing role of oil and gas as a contingency during New Zealand's energy transition. I also spoke of the importance of social licence and taking the public along on energy policy.
- 2 Investment meetings focused on profiling large scale infrastructure and energy projects in New Zealand, as well as food security and water storage investment opportunities in our regions.
- 3 International relations
- 4 Through the various engagements I had, it became clear that there is a strong degree of interest in the investment opportunities my delegation and I presented.
- 5 I met with Deputy Prime Minister GAN Kim Yong and Minister-in-charge of Trade Relations Grace FU. These engagements reaffirmed both sides' commitment to work closer together as New Zealand and Singapore approach 60 years of diplomatic relations in 2025, and comprised wide ranging discussion on food security, supply chain resilience, investment, and energy policy.
- 6 I met with a range of Temasek portfolio companies, including Keppel Group, Olam, SATS, ST Engineering, PSA Group, and Keppel Seghers. I also met

with energy shipping giant BW Group, the chairman of the Singapore Stock Exchange, and sovereign wealth fund GIC.

- 7 I also had site visits to the Tuas Port, ST Engineering drydock facilities and Keppel Seghers Waste to Energy Plant to observe the scale and technology of existing infrastructure projects in Singapore.
- 8 Confidentiality the anniversary of 60 years of New Zealand's bilateral relationship with Singapore.
- 9 Confidential information entrusted to the Government, Commercial information

- 11 The participation of Errol Clark as a Ministerial Advisor and Hon Murray McCully in his role as Chair of Te Tai Tokerau Water Trust and Chair of Far North Holdings Limited brought relevant opportunities for connection with their industry and investor networks in Singapore.
- 12 I also seek to inform Cabinet that an offer of accommodation was made by the Singapore Government following my proposed overseas travel paper. This was approved by the Prime Minister and Minister of Foreign Affairs.

13 I intend to release this Cabinet paper and associated minute within 30 days of final Cabinet decisions being made.
