### **Proposed Overseas Travel: Hon lain Lees-Galloway**

#### Portfolio Workplace Relations and Safety

On 20 May 2019, Cabinet:

- 1 **authorised** the absence of Hon Iain Lees-Galloway from New Zealand, subject to leave from Parliament being secured, from 15 to 21 June 2019 to travel to Geneva, Switzerland to attend the International Labour Conference;
- 2 **agreed** that he be accompanied by one member of staff;
- 3 **approved** the estimated expenditure of up to <sup>Confidentiality</sup> for the travel expenses of the Ministerial party as a charge to Vote: Internal Affairs (Members of the Executive Travel);

- 5 **agreed** that in his absence:
  - 5.1 Hon Peeni Henare act as Minister for ACC;
  - 5.2 Hon Kris Faafoi act as Minister of Immigration;
  - 5.3 Hon Andrew Little act as Minister for Workplace Relations and Safety.
