I went to the frontier ticket selling site from the newspaper, the top site that came up was Eagles tickets in Dunedin, I went into this site thinking it was the legitimate site, I ordered 4 tickets at \$307 each this was enough to get me on the field in the front section A. I then received an email from Viagogo saying I had secured my tickets and they would send them shortly.

I immediately rang my credit card dealer and asked them to cancel my payment, which was still pending, they could not cancel it.

My tickets arrived by email 2 months later, their face value was \$122 and they were on the field in D section, the section furtherest from the stage.

I emailed Viagogo numerous times and complained, but had no satisfaction.

The name on my tickets was Ramzy Ben Fatma, I asked if he worked for Viagogo but they did not answer this question.

I ended up so upset by my experience that I could not be bothered going to the concert, I think Viagogo totally ruined my enjoyment of a concert I was really looking forward to going to.
