Submission on publishing director's residential addresses on the Companies Register

In the interests of accountability, the connections between a person's directorships (and even their major shareholdings) should be easily identified on a well-maintained register that facilitates transparency. We strongly advocate that everyone has their current and past directorships and major shareholdings associated with each other by the use of a unique identifier per person, if residential addresses are not provided. Currently having a director or shareholders' residential address allows this to be achieved in most cases.
